**STAGE TIME:** Each team gets 9 minutes to practice on the stage. Parents may sit in the audience seating during stage time. The auditorium will be cleared after stage time. Saving seats is not allowed.

Dancers need to wear their team gear to stage time: **their real team shirt**, not a camp or Gem State one.

Senior teams: Warm-ups, black team shirt, black pants

PT/PJ/JR teams: Red Team Shirt, black pants

Dancers should arrive 20 minutes before their assigned time. Dancer may enter from the side door (stage entrance). Parents must enter from the front main doors. Hair and make-up does NOT need to be done for the stage time.

**DANCERS:** (Parents please read this to your dancer):

- During the show you can sit in the balcony or the dressings rooms. You are not allowed to wander around the school or to enter the main level audience seating. If you are leaving with your parents before the show is over, make a meeting spot in the lobby.
- Please be respectful of all other teams and dancers. Please cheer/applaud for ALL teams!!
- After you dance, change out of your costume, hang it or put it in the right container, and gather all your belongings. You may leave your bag in the dressing room, but you should have everything gathered!! We will note whose costumes are not put away - and I don't know what will happen to you... but it might be embarrassing!!!

**INFO FOR GIRLS: HAIR & MAKE-UP**

**PRE-TEENS & PRE-JUNIORS**

**Make-up:** We want our pre- dancers to look age appropriate, so just some light make up.

Using soft (pink tones) colors, please do 1. Cheek. 2. Lips. 3. Light eye shadow. 4. Mascara. No Eye Liner!.. No fake eyelashes!

**Hair:** Hair pulled back into a low bun. It doesn't have to be the fully gelled/slicked IBA bun, but please no fly-away hair. Should be well sprayed/gelled.

**JUNIORS & SENIORS:** We usually hold an in-person hair & make-up workshop, but we haven't been able to schedule that this year. Please watch the tutorial videos if you haven't been to a workshop.

**Make-up:** Please do full team make-up, using the colors in the team make-up kit. If this is your first year, please watch the tutorial video. Also, there will be Sr Team girls, and Coaches will be available to help. You can arrive earlier than 6:15 to get make-up help.

**Hair:** Please do a perfect IBA Bun. If you are new, watch the tutorial. If you aren't new - make sure that you don't get lazy with your hair! Plan enough time to do it right.

You must have a hair-net for your bun, the small weave. They are available at WM and Sally's.

**BOYS:** Hair should be neatly combed and then hair sprayed or gelled. Please have a fresh haircut! Boys should not wear any eye make up such as mascara or eyeliner. If eyebrows are very light, they can be gently filled with brow filler.

**CHAPERONES:** Your name will be at the ticket booth. Please check in there for your complimentary ticket. You will sit in the balcony with the dancers and prompt them to go down to line up 3 routines before they are on. Please be proactive in keeping our dancers quiet and respectful.

**FROM THE DIRECTOR:** The director of the show has sent these guidelines. Please read them to your dancer:

- **In the past sometimes the dancers have not always been supervised very closely and have been very disruptive during the concert. Your group must have a chaperone sitting with them. If a dancers are caught running through halls, throwing things over the balconies, or being disruptive they will be asked to leave and their team will be fined \$100**
- There will be no one allowed backstage and into the dressing areas except dancers and coaches. Please remind parents they cannot go back stage!! Several parents demanded to be allowed back stage before the show and were not very polite to those helping.
- There is to be **no one entering the side door of the auditorium except for dancers and coaches – ALL parents must enter through the main front doors**. There will be no saving seats. The coats or other items saving the seats during stage time will be removed before the lobby is opened. We will not open for seating until everything and everyone is cleared out.
